#### 一、活动名称

### HONOR EDUCATION 荣誉国际教育 | 英语故事演讲活动

#### 二、活动目的

本活动旨在鼓励幼稚园及小学生透过英语故事演讲，提升英语表达能力、发音技巧、语感、感情表达及台风表现，并培养对英语学习及公开表达的兴趣与自信。

#### 三、参加对象

本活动对象为：

- 幼稚园学生
- 小学生

参加者将按年级分为以下组别：

- 幼稚园组
- 初小组 (P1-P3)
- 高小组 (P4-P6)

#### 四、活动形式

本活动以录像提交形式进行。

参加者须以英语演讲指定故事，并于指定期限前提交参赛影片作评审。

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#### 五、参赛故事规定

为确保评审标准一致及活动公平，参加者必须按所属组别，于指定故事中选择其中一篇参赛，不接受自选故事。参加者须按照本章程所载之指定故事名称、作者及内容版本演讲，不得自行更改内容、增删段落、重新编写或另选其他版本。

##### 高小组 (P4-P6)

参加者须于以下故事中选择一篇参赛：

- 《The Fox and the Crow》
- 《The Goose That Laid the Golden Eggs》
- 《The Wind and the Sun》
- 《The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse》

#### 参赛故事注意事项

1. 每位参加者只可提交一篇英语故事参赛。
2. 参赛作品必须为所属组别指定故事之一。
3. 参加者须按照本章程所载之指定版本全文演讲。

4. 不接受名单以外之作品。
  5. 不得自行修改故事内容、增删段落、重新编写或更换版本。
  6. 如提交作品不符合指定要求，主办方有权取消参赛资格或不予评审。

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## 高小组 (P4-P6)

The town mouse said, "Come with me to the town. I will show you a better life."  
So they went to a big house in the town, where there was plenty of rich and delicious food.  
But just as they began to eat, they heard a loud noise.  
The mice ran away quickly and hid.  
Again and again, they were frightened by people and dogs.

At last, the country mouse said, "I would rather live simply and safely in the country than live in fear in the town."

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## 七、影片要求

参赛影片须符合以下要求：

1. 参加者须以英语清楚演讲。
2. 影片需清楚拍摄参加者样貌。
3. 影片声音必须清晰，避免过大杂音。
4. 影片可使用直向或横向拍摄。
5. 建议片长为 1 至 3 分钟。
6. 影片内容须完整，不得只提交部分内容。
7. 不建议加入过多后期音效或剪接效果，以免影响评审公平。
8. 如影片无法播放、画面不清、声音不清、资料不完整或逾期提交，主办方有权不予受理。

## 十、评审准则

评审将按以下五个范畴评核参赛作品：

### 1. 发音

评估英语发音是否准确、清晰、自然。

### 2. 节奏

评估演讲语速、停顿、语调及语句流畅度。

### 3. 感情

评估参加者能否恰当表达故事内容与情感。

### 4. 台风

评估仪态、表情、自信及整体演绎表现。

### 5. 整体表现

评估作品整体完成度、感染力及综合效果。

## 十一、评级制度

每个评审项目将按表现分为以下等级：

- A 级
- B 级

- C 级
- D 级

评审将根据各项表现作综合评核，并给予最终总评级。

## 十二、奖项安排

根据最终总评级，参加者将获颁以下奖项：

- A 级：金奖
- B 级：银奖
- C 级：铜奖
- D 级：优良表现奖

## 十三、证书安排

1. 每位完成报名并提交合资格作品之参加者，将按最终评级获发相应证书。
2. 证书形式、发放方法及日期将由主办方另行公布。
3. 如因报名者填写资料错误而需重新制作证书，主办方有权收取行政费用。

## 十四、结果公布

1. 比赛结果将由主办方以指定方式公布。
2. 主办方可透过 Facebook 专页、WhatsApp、电邮或其他方式通知家长。
3. 所有评审结果以主办方最终公布为准。
