#### 一、活動名稱

### HONOR EDUCATION 榮譽國際教育 | 英語故事演講活動

#### 二、活動目的

本活動旨在鼓勵幼稚園及小學生透過英語故事演講，提升英語表達能力、發音技巧、語感、感情表達及台風表現，並培養對英語學習及公開表達的興趣與自信。

#### 三、參加對象

本活動對象為：

- 幼稚園學生
- 小學生

參加者將按年級分為以下組別：

- 幼稚園組
- 初小組（P1-P3）
- 高小組（P4-P6）

#### 四、活動形式

本活動以錄影提交形式進行。

參加者須以英語演講指定故事，並於指定期限前提交參賽影片作評審。

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#### 五、參賽故事規定

為確保評審標準一致及活動公平，參加者必須按所屬組別，於指定故事中選擇其中一篇參賽，不接受自選故事。參加者須按照本章程所載之指定故事名稱、作者及內容版本演講，不得自行更改內容、增刪段落、重新編寫或另選其他版本。

##### 幼稚園組

- 《The Hare and the Tortoise》
- 《The Boy Who Cried Wolf》

##### 初小組（P1-P3）

參加者須於以下故事中選擇一篇參賽：

- 《The Hare and the Tortoise》
- 《The Boy Who Cried Wolf》
- 《The Ant and the Grasshopper》

##### 高小組（P4-P6）

參加者須於以下故事中選擇一篇參賽：

- 《The Fox and the Crow》
- 《The Goose That Laid the Golden Eggs》
- 《The Wind and the Sun》
- 《The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse》

#### 參賽故事注意事項

1. 每位參加者只可提交一篇英語故事參賽。
2. 參賽作品必須為所屬組別指定故事之一。
3. 參加者須按照本章程所載之指定版本全文演講。

4. 不接受名單以外之作品。
  5. 不得自行修改故事內容、增刪段落、重新編寫或更換版本。
  6. 如提交作品不符合指定要求，主辦方有權取消參賽資格或不予評審。
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## 六、指定故事材料（以本章程所載版本為準）

### 幼稚園組

#### 1. 《The Lion and the Mouse》

作者：Aesop

One day, a lion was sleeping in the forest.  
A little mouse ran across his paw.  
The lion woke up and caught the mouse.  
The mouse said, "Please let me go. One day I may help you."  
The lion laughed, but he let the mouse go.  
A few days later, the lion was caught in a hunter's net.  
He roared loudly.  
The mouse heard him and ran to help.  
It bit the net with its sharp teeth and set the lion free.  
The lion said, "Thank you, little mouse."

The mouse smiled and said, "Even a small friend can help a great lion."

#### 2. 《The Hare and the Tortoise》

作者：Aesop

A hare was proud because he could run very fast.  
He laughed at the tortoise for being slow.  
The tortoise said, "Let us have a race."  
The hare agreed and laughed again.  
When the race began, the hare ran far ahead.  
Soon he stopped to rest under a tree.  
He thought, "The tortoise is very slow. I can sleep for a while."  
So the hare fell asleep.  
The tortoise kept walking slowly and steadily.  
At last, he passed the sleeping hare and reached the finish line first.  
When the hare woke up, it was too late.  
The tortoise had won the race.

#### 3. 《The Boy Who Cried Wolf》

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## 高小組 (P4-P6)

### 1. 《The Fox and the Crow》

作者：Aesop

One day, a crow found a piece of cheese and flew up to a tree.  
A fox saw the cheese and wanted it very much.  
He looked up at the crow and said, "What a beautiful bird you are! Your feathers are so shiny, and your wings are so lovely. I am sure your voice is just as beautiful. Please sing for me."  
The crow was very pleased.  
She opened her beak to sing.  
But as soon as she opened her mouth, the cheese fell to the ground.  
The fox quickly grabbed it and ran away.  
He said, "Thank you, crow. Remember, do not trust people who flatter you too much."

### 2. 《The Goose That Laid the Golden Eggs》

A farmer had a goose that laid one golden egg every day.  
The farmer and his wife were very happy, and soon they became rich.  
But after some time, they became greedy.  
They thought, "Why should we wait for one egg a day? The goose must have many golden eggs inside."

Now they had no goose and no more golden eggs.  
Because of their greed, they lost everything.

### 3. 《The Wind and the Sun》

One day, the wind and the sun argued about who was stronger.  
They saw a man walking along the road, wearing a coat.  
The wind said, "Whoever can make the man take off his coat is stronger."  
So the wind blew as hard as he could.  
But the more he blew, the more tightly the man held his coat around himself.  
Then the sun began to shine warmly and gently.  
Soon the man felt hot and took off his coat.  
The sun smiled and said, "Gentleness and warmth are stronger than force."

### 4. 《The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse》

作者：Aesop

A country mouse lived a simple life in the fields.  
One day, his cousin, the town mouse, came to visit him.  
The country mouse offered him plain food like roots and grains.  
The town mouse said, "Come with me to the town. I will show you a better life."  
So they went to a big house in the town, where there was plenty of rich and delicious food.  
But just as they began to eat, they heard a loud noise.  
The mice ran away quickly and hid.  
Again and again, they were frightened by people and dogs.

At last, the country mouse said, “I would rather live simply and safely in the country than live in fear in the town.”

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## 七、影片要求

參賽影片須符合以下要求：

1. 參加者須以英語清楚演講。
2. 影片需清楚拍攝參加者樣貌。
3. 影片聲音必須清晰，避免過大雜音。
4. 影片可使用直向或橫向拍攝。
5. 建議片長為 1 至 3 分鐘。
6. 影片內容須完整，不得只提交部分內容。
7. 不建議加入過多後期音效或剪接效果，以免影響評審公平。
8. 如影片無法播放、畫面不清、聲音不清、資料不完整或逾期提交，主辦方有權不予受理。

## 十、評審準則

評審將按以下五個範疇評核參賽作品：

### 1. 發音

評估英語發音是否準確、清晰、自然。

### 2. 節奏

評估演講語速、停頓、語調及語句流暢度。

### 3. 感情

評估參加者能否恰當表達故事內容與情感。

### 4. 台風

評估儀態、表情、自信及整體演繹表現。

### 5. 整體表現

評估作品整體完成度、感染力及綜合效果。

## 十一、評級制度

每個評審項目將按表現分為以下等級：

- A 級
- B 級

- C 級
- D 級

評審將根據各項表現作綜合評核，並給予最終總評級。

## 十二、獎項安排

根據最終總評級，參加者將獲頒以下獎項：

- A 級：金獎
- B 級：銀獎
- C 級：銅獎
- D 級：優良表現獎

## 十三、證書安排

1. 每位完成報名並提交合資格作品之參加者，將按最終評級獲發相應證書。
2. 證書形式、發放方法及日期將由主辦方另行公布。
3. 如因報名者填寫資料錯誤而需重新製作證書，主辦方有權收取行政費用。

## 十四、結果公布

1. 比賽結果將由主辦方以指定方式公布。
2. 主辦方可透過 Facebook 專頁、WhatsApp、電郵或其他方式通知家長。
3. 所有評審結果以主辦方最終公布為準。

## 十五、照片、影片及資料使用

1. 參加者提交之影片及資料將用作報名核實、行政處理、活動評審及結果公布用途。
2. 在家長或監護人同意下，主辦方可使用參加者之姓名、相片、影片片段或活動成果作合理宣傳用途，包括但不限於 Facebook 專頁、活動海報及成果展示。
3. 如家長不同意公開展示，請於報名時註明。

## 十六、退款及更改安排

1. 報名一經確認及付款，一般情況下不設退款。
2. 如因特殊情況、行政安排或其他不可抗力因素導致活動取消或更改，主辦方將另行通知有關安排。
3. 主辦方保留更改活動日期、評審安排、提交方式、證書形式及其他細節之權利。
